XCEL Head Coaches Workshop

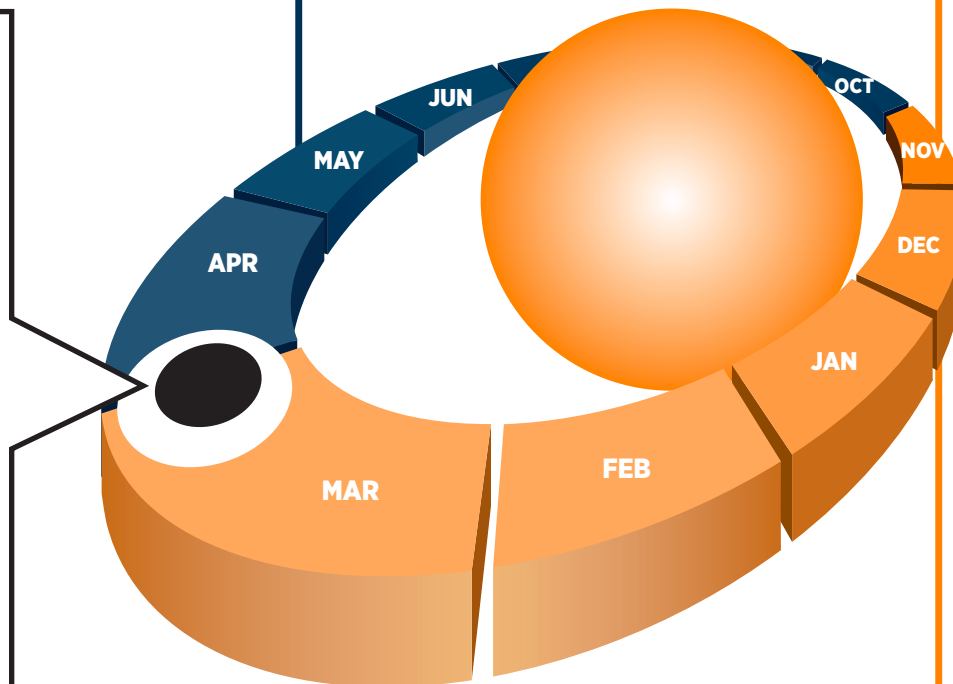
Invitation-only afternoon workshop for 30 NCAA Division I coaches to discuss current issues.

In-Season Programs

Coach to Coach Mentor Program

458 coaches participating this year, grouped in huddles of four to six coaches two mentors per huddle. Huddles are grouped by need or want, for example an assistant coach who wants to become a head coach one day may be grouped with a new head coach. Each huddle has one call per month for 60 minutes. Focus is on peer-to-peer support and information sharing, encouragement, building relationships.

Monthly webinar series

A variety of topics, one topic per month. Each webinar lasts 30 minutes, scheduled during the lunch hour.
