## WHAT IT IS

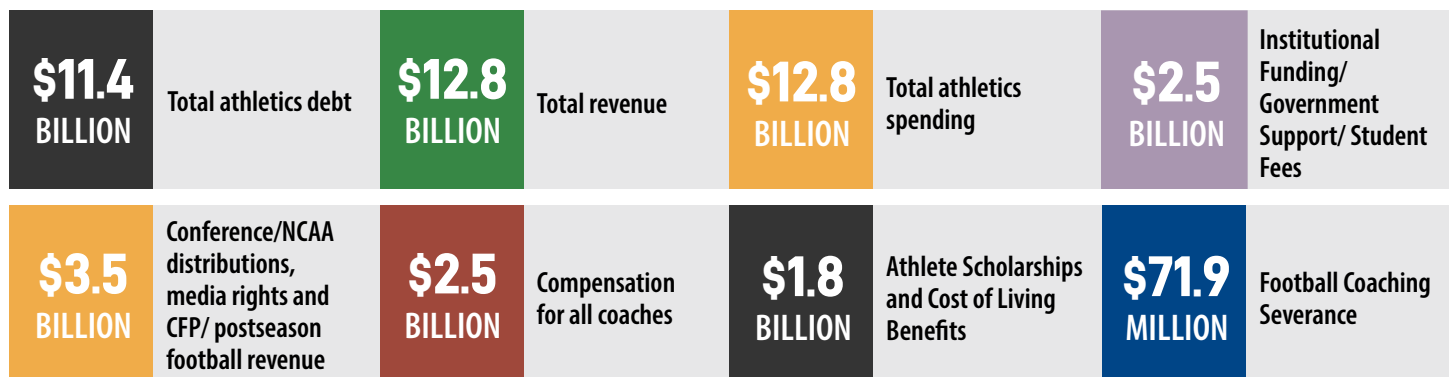
The **Knight-Newhouse College Athletics Database** ([knightnewhousedata.org](http://knightnewhousedata.org)) is an authoritative source for understanding college sports finances. The interactive, user-friendly tool provides access to athletics revenues, expenses, and debt at more than 230 public NCAA Division I colleges and universities dating back to 2005. Academic spending data are also available. This database is an essential tool for providing greater financial transparency as college sports undergoes significant changes.

## HOW IT WORKS

- Database graphics visually show where the money comes from and where the money goes in college sports.
- A robust custom report feature allows users to analyze finances for user-defined peer groups; run trend reports; and download data.
- Interactive and free use options allow users to extract and embed prepared and custom data visualizations.
